• How often?


• In what order?

Try to do it in this order:

- Check your main security programs.
 - Microsoft Security Essentials (or whatever you use)
 - Malwarebytes (or whatever you use)
- Check for Microsoft updates.
- Run Malwarebytes.
- Run Ccleaner.
 - Cleaner Registry Startup
- Defrag your hard drive.



(some may require a double click)






CryptoLocker

• New form of malware being called ransomware.

• Extremely severe.

• How can I get it? ...or not get it!


CryptoLocker is a malicious program that falls into a category of malware called ransomware. Once installed on a computer, ransomware applications typically prevent victims from accessing their files or even their operating system until they pay money to the malware authors.

How it actually works:

- CryptoLocker disguises itself to resemble a legitimate attachment connected to a seemingly genuine email from established companies.
- The attachment is disguised in a PDF form. This malware is able to save itself in the targeted computer's Documents and Settings folder with a random name.
- The payload then proceeds to encrypt files <u>across local hard drives</u> and <u>mapped network drives</u>. The process encrypts <u>photos</u> and other data files with certain extensions including Microsoft Office, Microsoft Excel, and Microsoft PowerPoint.'

Here is what they want:

• Once the encryption was completed, the program displays a message informing the user what has happened. In return for access to the private decryption key needed to decrypt the files, the message demands a payment of \$300 be delivered to the hackers via an anonymous pre-paid cash voucher.



What can you do to prevent infection?

- Keep antivirus and malware up-to-date.
- Be cautious of opening unsolicited email attachments or clicking on unknown links.
 - Especially about shipping from known companies.
 - Especially if it ends in *.pdf or *.pdf.exe.

Be alert and pay attention!
